## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1) Each of you must use two devices to register the audio-video file.

In the first (better the computer but also a tablet or a phone is fine) you will listen IN HEADSET (so that any sound absolutely does not filter outside the device) your audio track.

With the second (your mobile phone or tablet) you will record your track on video; that is, you will film yourself whilst you sing on the track you are listening to.

- 2) Once the video has been recorded on your phone, you must send it to AERCO (via WeTransfer, to aercobologna@gmail.com) which will take care of the cleaning and footage. If you record on your mobile phone, you will first need to transfer the file from your phone to your PC (there are various ways to do it, including Bluetooth or Airdrop for those who have an iPhone or a Mac computer).
- 3) as regards the registration, it is absolutely necessary to adhere to these guidelines:
- a) the shot is important. Try to keep your head in the center, all visible leaving a homogeneous frame around the head. This is because the shots will have to be cut and if you keep the top of the corresponding head with the upper edge of the shot then you will end up with the head cut off!
- b) keep the phone in horizontal position.
- c) sing with a natural voice, without shouting too much. The singing must be harmonious, with attention to the attacks and the endings (do not prolong or anticipate the notes) and above all in time; for this you may help yourself with the 'click' of the track.
- d) make sure that you start the recording earlier than the help track. Likewise, once you finish the track, end the recording first.
- e) if possible, do not wear pajamas or sports suit.
- f) listen to how the recording came about. If you notice technical or interpretation errors, do it again.
- g) When you sing do not look down but straight into the camera. This means that you should not keep the score on the table but better behind the phone at the same shooting height.
- 4) As for the help track, it contains an 'empty' bar before the song starts. This beat is made up of 4 beats (because the tempo is 4/4) of which the first beat performs the reference note. Try it first to understand it well.
